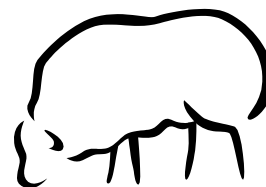

Use directions below - MapQuest will get you close, then get you lost.

- Hwy 16, Exit for Purdy/Key Center//Shelton, Hwy 302 W.
- Travel into Purdy, Turn left at the signal following sign for Hwy 302W (Shelton/Key Center)
- Cross Wauna Bridge, travel 5.1 miles
- Turn **RIGHT** onto Hwy 302 W, Elgin Clifton Rd KPN, toward Shelton/Allyn (There are clearly marked signs leading to Hwy 302 W)
- Travel 1.2 miles, turn **RIGHT** onto 150th
- Travel .1 miles (end of chain link fence) turn **LEFT** onto 1st road into Rocky Creek Conservation Area
- Follow road approximately .8 mile through park, to PackLeader's green farm gate, follow road past two-story house (white w/green trim) to parking lot at the top of the driveway.

GENERAL RULES:

- Time 15 minutes.
- In all elements, quiet efficient stock work is essential.
- All elements must be accomplished prior to moving on.
- All gates may be open/closed at the Handler's discretion (unless specified); however, time will not end until all gates have been restored to their original/starting position.
- Ties are broken based on individual scores in the following order: Exercise 7 "Sort and Pen", Exercise 5 "Footbath", Time.

STARTING SET- UP:

All gates are closed, except Pens #2 & #3 to Narrow Alley, which are open.
25 sheep in Arena B, 25 sheep in Trailer, 25 sheep in 3 groups located in Alley C/D, 25+ sheep in reserve.

1. **GATHER - 15 pts.:** Enter Arena B and move to the position appropriate for the team's level. Gather sheep and fetch the sheep to the Handler, and return to Handler's Post. Turn sheep clockwise around the Handler's Post and proceed to Pen #3. Exercise ends when the sheep reach Pen #3.

RLF I Dog at 75 feet from sheep, Handler within 15 feet of sheep.

RLF II Dog at 150 feet from sheep, Handler ½ way.

RLF III Handler and dog 150 feet from sheep

2. **RLF III ONLY: Obstacle #1 - 10 pts.:** After gather, handler remains at the Handler's Post, while the dog drives the sheep toward Obstacle #1, turn the sheep right passing thru the obstacle. Sheep are then turned left and taken to Pen #3. Handler may leave the Handler's Post when the sheep pass the plane of the obstacle. Exercise ends when the sheep reach Pen #3.

3. **NARROW ALLEY - 10 pts.:** All levels: Dog will hold the stock off Pen #3 gate, allowing the handler to freely open the gate. Move stock through Pen #3, down Narrow Alley, through Pen #2 and into Arena A. Exercise ends when Arena A gate is closed.

4. **FETCH/DRIVE - 20 pts.:** All levels: Proceed to the Handler's Post. From the Handler's Post fetch/drive sheep through free standing Obstacle #2 and back to the Handler's Post. Dog will hold the stock near the Handler's Post while the handler proceeds to the gate for Pen #2. Handler recalls the dog and team exits Arena A thru Pen #2. Exercise ends when Pen #2 gate is closed.

RLF I Handler may take any position.

RLF II Handler must remain behind the Handler's Line while the stock are taken thru Obstacle #2.

RLF III Handler must remain at the Handler's Post until the stock return to the Handler's Post.

5. **FOOTBATH - 10 pts.:** All levels: Proceed to Trailer. Remove sheep from Trailer, move sheep through Footbath and release in Arena B. Exercise ends when Arena B gate is closed.

6. **PENS/TRAILER - 15 pts.:** All levels: Take sheep from pens in Alley C/D, combine sheep and move them through Pen #2 into the Upper Back Alley, thru Pen #3 and load into Trailer (bypass the Footbath). Exercise ends when the Trailer gate is closed.

RLF I & II Handlers may take any position.

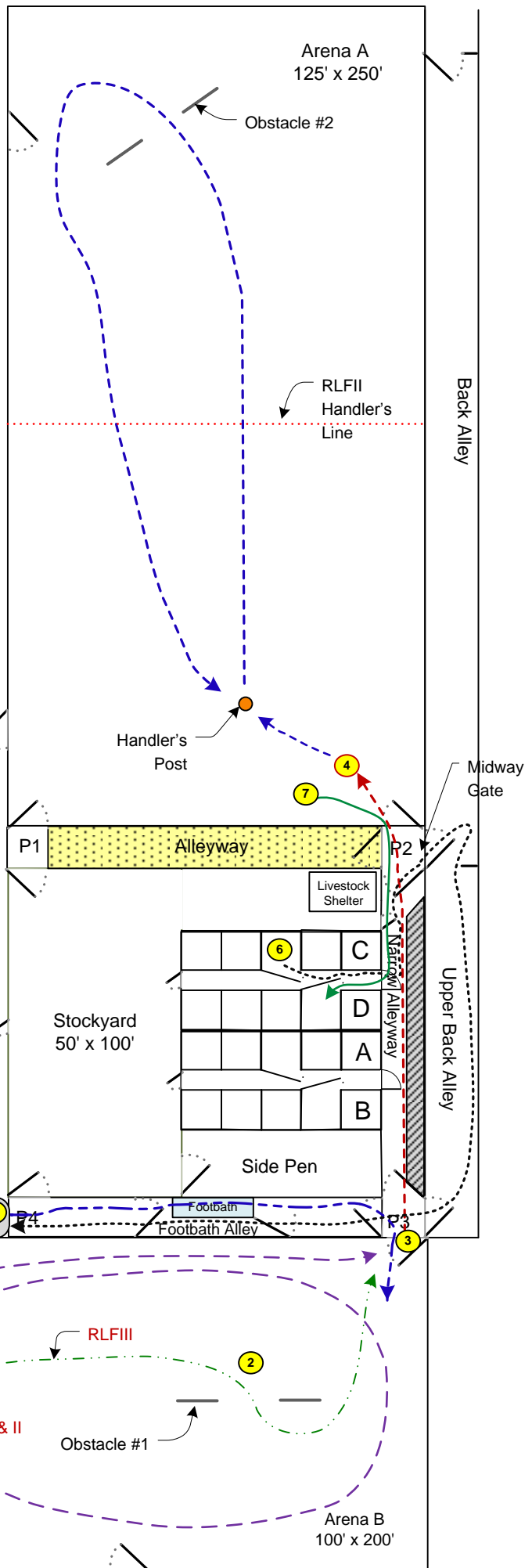
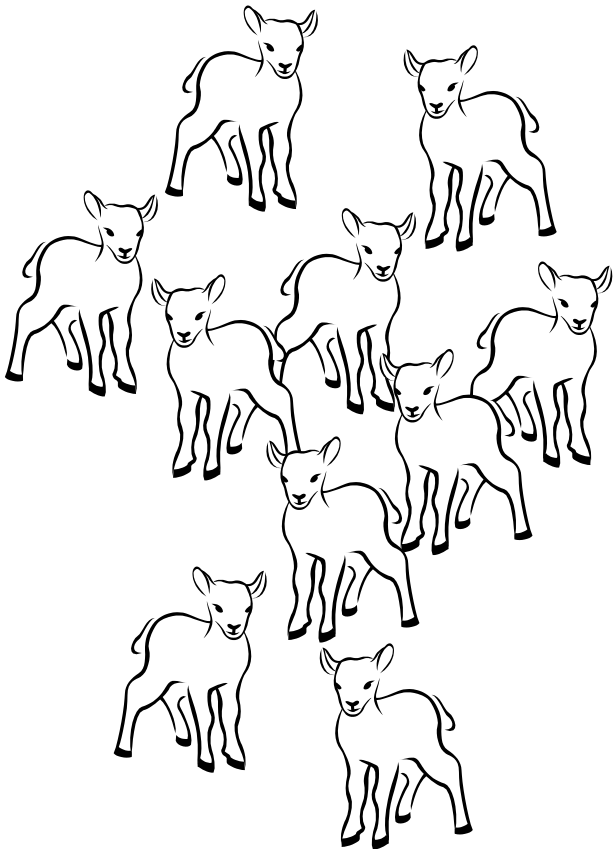
RLF III Handler must remain in the Narrow Alley until the stock reach Pen #3.

7. **SORT AND PEN - 20 pts.:** All levels: Return to Arena A, gather sheep, move thru Pen #2 and sort sheep into 3 groups of 10, 10 & 5 sheep. Pen in separate pens in Alley C/D. Sort may be done anywhere between Arena A and pens in Alley C/D. Exercise ends when sheep are penned.

Time stops when **ALL** gates have been restored to their original/starting position.
